The Municipality of Abbiategrasso has initiated a vari-


ance procedure for its town planning scheme (PGT) in force, in order to revise the city transformation strategies set out by the previous Town-Council.

Starting off from the investigation of the state of the existing local planning, Kcity was requested to design and manage a working path that could lead to identify territorial strategies underpinning the plan variance, through strong involvement on the part of resident population and local organisations.

Among the activities that ensure a considerable improvement and strengthening of the relationships between the local actors are the following: mapping grassroots initiatives that support territorial governance; paying attention to the viewpoint of key informants, stakeholders and various institutional bodies; workshops on issues and projects apt to enhance diffused competences and resources.

Thanks to the project implementation methods, the usefulness of the final product exceeds the objectives of a mere reformulation of the planning tools. It may be considered an innovative experiment for a strategic cross-sector agenda, able to create local planning initiatives aimed at maximizing the use of available resources.
