The context is Antigorio and Formazza Valleys and the municipalities of Crodo, Baceno, Premia and Formazza. The resident population is approx. 3300 people, most of whom are over 65 with peaks in the territory of Baceno. In these mountain territories the phenomenon of the growth of the elderly population is now constant, while the lengthening of life expectancy is modifying the needs of the population, affecting health care services.

INSIEME proposed the implementation of a pilot project that aimed to activate new strategies and policies for modulating the supply of home health interventions, for the elderly and for non self-sufficient residents living in mountain areas. Thanks to the experience already successfully launched in the nearby Canton Ticino, INSIEME proposed the implementation of an innovative process of assistance to the nonself-sufficient based on the principle of home automation in Valle Antigorio and Formazza.

The assignment provided the technical assistance for the application of the Municipality of Formazza to the 1 call of the European Territorial Cooperation Program INTERREG ITA CH (2014-2020) opened in two phases: through the definition and development of the project idea (manifestation of interest) and through the preparation of the complete application form for the call for applications (finalization of the loan application).

The call for applications included the selection of applications in two phases, INSIEME was among the projects selected for the first phase but was not the subject of funding in the second and last phase.
